

# The Decorating Leprechaun

This is how I made my version of a rotary cutter embellishing tool based on the new Henry Taylor "Decorating Elf" designed by William Hudson.

## Parts Needed:

### Dremel Bits

- #114 5/16" Round (\$6.00)
- #115 5/16" Straight (optional)
- #144 5/16" Bud (optional)
- 1/8" x 5/16" ball bearing from hobby shop (1 or 2) (\$4.00 ea)
- 5/32" Brass Tubing for spacer (\$1.32)
- 1/2" Diameter X 5" long Brass Rod (scrap bin)
- Natural Bristle Paint Brush
- Make a comfortable tool handle (free)



## Tools Needed:

- 5/16" Center Drill and 5/32" Twist Drill Bits
- Medium CA Glue

## Process:

1. Chuck up the brass rod
2. Using countersink bit, drill to depth for 1 or 2 bearings
3. Drill 5/32" dia hole deep enough for the Dremel bit shaft
4. CA glue in the bearings
5. Cut brass tubing into 1/4" lengths for spacers. Use utility knife and roll on table.
6. Insert brass tool shank into your tool handle
7. Cut the bristles of the Boar's hair brush short to make a burnishing brush
